

- 1. RT -PCR test to be done in India within 48 hours of your departure Cost is approx INR 500 per person in India. For RT-PCR test you have to compulsory given your name as per Passport. (QR Code is Mandatory on Covid Report)
- 2. Need to Reach at India Airport before 6 Hr. of Departure time for Rapid Test and Cost will be approx -INR 2000 to INR 3000 Per person.
- 3. Rapid test at the UAE airport will be done on arrival after Immigration without any charges as of now-Report will be given within 12 -24 hours. Till then you have to stay at your hotel only.
- 4. While return from Dubai to India then again you need to do PCR test within 48 hours of Departure from

- UAE and It cost is approx 150 250 AED. It is also possible to arrange with Transfer from your Hotel and this additional cost you need to pay directly.
- 5. Test has to be done in approved labs or Hospital in UAE.
- 6. Guest needs to do PCR test in India, if the Tests Results comes out to be Negative then he / she will be allowed to Travel and upon reaching UAE, the report should not be more than 48 hours old
- 7. Printout of the PCR test result is mandatory.
- 8. Please note if USA VISA holder is travelling to Dubai, there is one formality that pax passport they are scanning and sending that to Dubai for Visa approval. They do not provide any visa from here but they need to re confirm this from Dubai once. Also note while coming from Dubai to India, Client need to fill up AIR SUVIDHA Form, Self Declaration Form and RT PCR Test which is mandatory.
- 9. Test has to be done at the approved labs in India and Find the below is link: https://covid19cc.nic.in/icmr/Citizen/LabList.aspx
- 10. In India itself, Guest will have to download the Covid19-DXB Smart App and they will have to update a UAE number on which the test results will be shared and also the results will be shared on the App.

- 13. For Abu Dhabi Arrival download ALHOSN app
- 14. Health Declaration form to be filled and submitted at Indian Airport. Link: https://c.ekstatic.net/ecl/documents/dubai-health-declaration-form.pdf
- 15. In flight, Airline Crew will be sharing a form to fill up the Basic Details along with India and UAE contact number and email ID. Link: https://c.ekstatic.net/ecl/documents/dubai-arrivals-quarantine-procedure-declaration-form-july.pdf
- 16. Upon reaching UAE, there will be one more test done at the Airport and that result will come in 24 Hours to 36 Hours and till then the Guest will not be allowed to move around and will have to keep himself isolated at the Hotel
- 17. Once the Guest will receive his test results claiming it to be Negative then they can move around Abu Dhabi /Dubai
- 18. If you are travelling to Dubai, you need to carry a Covid-19 Test Report, Your Visa Copy, Travel Insurance and Self Declaration Form.
- 19. You need to show it to the Dubai Health Authority Employees at the Airport on Arrival before proceeding to the Immigration Counters.
- 20. All the Passengers need to go through another round of PCR test at the Arrival Point and Download the covid-19 app to get the result.
- 21. If you have a Negative test result, then you can go without Quarantine (can change on case to case basis)
- 22. However, if you come up with a positive test result on arrival, then you need to be in self-quarantine for 14 days and do the test again.
- 23. You can then go to the Baggage Carousels to collect your bags, then walk towards the Exit Gates totake a Taxi, a Ride on the Metro or be picked up by your Friend or Relative.
- 24. Above rules and regulations can be changed anytime by the authorities without any prior updates

# **GOT QUESTIONS?**

### **GENERAL**

# Q: Is Dubai open for tourists?

Dubai being a second largest emirate is now ready to welcome travelers from all corners of the world. The Supreme committee of Crisis and disaster management in a press release stated that Dubai would reopen for tourists from 7th July 2020.

Q: Do I need a Covid-19 test done when travelling to Dubai?

Yes, everyone who are traveling out to Dubai from any destination must have a printed negative Covid 19 PCR test declaration in English or Arabic and the test must be directed before 96 hours (for example 4 days) of the takeoff.

Q: What if I test positive after reaching Dubai airport?

If you undergo a test at the airport, you have to stay in your hotel or a residence until and unless you receive the test result. And if the test results are positive you need to undergo 14 days isolation and follow the guidelines by Dubai Health Authority.

Q: Are children and newborn kids subject to Covid-19 tests?

A recent announcement has brought in a sigh of relief to a lot of passengers that the Kids under 12 years of age traveling from India to UAE need not to undergo the COVID PCR test.

Q: Are there any rules to follow when in Dubai?

Responsibilities of travelers:

- Travelers should strictly follow the isolation guidelines in case of any symptom and the test is positive
- Take precautionary measures like wear masks, use sanitizers and maintain social distancing
- Disclose any symptom before traveling by filling the form provided by the airlines
- Tourists will have to bear the costs of examination and treatment abroad of they are infected with Covid 19, hence they all are advised to have International health insurance before travelling.

# Q: Do tourists need to be quarantined mandatorily?

Travelers, who are able to show valid, recognized tests and are not showing any Covid-19 symptoms, will not be quarantined or tested in Dubai. However, those who fail to undergo the test before traveling will be screened by the medics on the arrival at Dubai airport and if the test results are positive you need to undergo 14 days isolation and follow the guidelines by Dubai Health Authority.

**Q:** Are there any restrictions in Dubai? What is open or closed?

As Dubai announces the relaxation of some restrictions all the shopping malls, high-street shops, souqs and all the entertainment and leisure attractions like Dubai Aquarium, Burj Khalifa, water parks are now ready to welcome tourists.

### Q: How to reach Dubai?

**By Air:** Dubai has the metropolis airport of the emirates. <u>Flights</u> land here from all countries. Some popular airports in Dubai are Al Maktoum International Airport that is 32km southwest Dubai in Jebel Ali.

The second Airport is Dubai International Airport which is located in Dubai itself. It is located in the Emirates of Abu Dhabi. Some of the international flights like Emirates, Fly Dubai, Spice Jet, Air India, Jet Airways and Indigo, Kuwait take you to Dubai from India.

### Q: Do I need a visa to visit Dubai from India?

Yes, Indian residents do require a visa to visit Dubai. It takes around 4-6 days to process a tourist visa. According to the new Dubai Visa policy, Indian citizens can get visa-on-arrival valid for 14 days if they hold a residence visa for the US or UK countries. All you need to do is to fill a form on arrival and pay an approximate sum of Rs 2,250.

### Q: What is the best time to visit Dubai?

<u>The best time to visit Dubai</u> is throughout the winter months, from November to April. January and February see overwhelming traveler traffic due to the Dubai Shopping Festival, which brings life to the city. Dubai is hot in summer but during this season you can get great deals in comparison to other months.

### Q: What is the best mode to commute in Dubai?

Dubai is a city where everything goes right, and when it comes to commuting Dubai is way beyond our imagination. Here are some of the best ways to commute to Dubai.

**Metro:** The Dubai Metro framework spans 75 km with the majority of the course covering Dubai's fundamental highway. There are carriages dedicated to women and children, as well as VIP carriages upfront. Go, gold class, get a drivers' eye view (these trains are driverless so this cabin gets the best view).

**Careem or Uber:** Careem is Dubai's home-grown driver service, which allows you to book a range of private cars as well as RTA taxis, plus you have the flexibility to pay by card or cash. Simply download the app and there you go! Uber is equally popular, particularly with travelers who already have the app.

### Q: Which sim card is reasonably priced in Dubai?

Some of the best and reasonably priced sim cards in Dubai are Etisalat, Diu, Virgin Mobile etc. They are easily available at airport and mobile stores in the city.

# Q: When is the Dubai Shopping Festival Held?

Dubai Shopping Festival 2020 will be held from 26th December 2019 to 1st February 2020. It is called the biggest shopping and entertainment event in the Middle East.

### Q: Can I consume alcohol in Dubai?

The Dubai Emirate permits residents to consume liquor in that Emirate only if they have an alcohol license. Tourists can purchase and consume liquor at licensed venues, like hotels, eateries, and clubs. Meanwhile, in Sharjah drinking liquor is unlawful.

## Q: Till when are the shopping malls open in Dubai?

All the major malls in Dubai including Dubai Mall, Mall of the Emirates, City Centre Deira are open till midnight but the timings are extended till 2 am during Ramadan. A few food courts in selected malls remain open till 3 am during the holy month.

# Q: On Friday's is everything closed in Dubai?

Banks, government and private offices are shut on Friday with a few exceptions as it is a weekly off. The malls, restaurants, shopping centers, and other tourist hubs remain open on all days barring a few shops which close for an hour for the Friday prayer.
