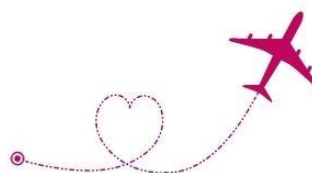

IMPORTANT NOTES

- Guests who have been infected and fully recovered from COVID within 90 days of travel are recommended to carry
- A medical certificate from the doctor that clearly states that you have had COVID on (Date) and you have successfully undergone 7-day quarantine & treatment for Covid as per protocol.
- Copy of your earlier RTPCR test within 90 days of travel showing you were tested positive.
- Received a Negative COVID test result post the quarantine. *The letter should also carry your Passport details.
- In case you are tested positive on arrival, you may produce these documents to the hospital team and there is a good chance you would be issued a medical certificate sharing that despite your positive result, the
- positive result falls within the 90 days guideline per CDC for still testing positive and present minimal risk for transmission. The final verdict of course is of the hospital and doctor concerned. This is not guaranteed but
- most likely if you present the documents and present your case.
- Supporting Documents: The COVID positive Test result, Pre-travel negative test result along with the Medical Certificate issued by your doctor.
- For guests who were infected with COVID, outside 90 days before travel, the above will not apply. If they test positive upon arrival in Bangkok, they will be required to go through the full quarantine procedure as
- prescribed by the Thailand Government.
- Guests staying 5 nights or more, are recommended not to book any tour or activity on Day 5 to accommodate time for the RTPCR test.

WAITING TIME TRANSFER AND TOURS:

- SIC Waiting Time: Tours & Transfers: 5 minutes from the arrival of guide/driver for pickup.
- PVT Waiting Time: Tours & Transfers: 30 minutes from the arrival of guide/driver for pick-up
- Guests should be at the waiting area as per itinerary, at least 5 minutes prior to the pickup start time.
- Driver / Guide will leave after the specified waiting time. If the guests are not present at the pickup point, service will be considered a No Show.

GOT QUESTIONS?

GENERAL

Q: What is the difference between group tours and individual tours?

Group tours consist of certain number of people touring together to a destination. Group tours can be a great way to know new people and explore well planned itinerary covering the best places. No changes will be possible in your group tour itinerary. In each destination the group consists of approximately 40 to 55 members.

Individual tours are tailor made tours designed and arranged just for you. You have a liberty to choose your own hotels, and attractions as per your taste.

Q: What are the different modes of transportation provided to passengers on tour?

At the time of booking, passengers are given different options to choose their mode of transportation like:

In Private Transfer you can also choose to do sightseeing by private vehicle which will be available from one point to another. The private vehicle will be pre-booked on a pre-decided route and timings decided in advance as well.

Vehicle at disposal means that a car will be with you throughout the travel trip for which timings and kilometers will be decided in advance. If you use the car outside the travel package distance or time limit then it may not be possible or it will charged additionally. Vehicle at disposal offers more flexibility and control over the itinerary. Also private van tours include a coach at service.

SIC (Seat in coach basis) SIC coach transfers depart only at fixed times and stop at different hotels enroute where other passengers may be picked up or dropped off which mean it time consuming. You will be traveling with other passengers and passengers of different nationalities which offers a good chance to interact with people from different parts of the world. Before joining the tour you need to exchange tour vouchers for your original tickets from the concerned office. Many time the tour starting point is not from the hotel so then you need to reach the departure point from your hotel at your own expense.

Q: What kind of food is offered to travelers on tour?

Meals which will be provided on tour will be mentioned in your tour itinerary. Usually meal menu contains of Indian vegetarian food, Jain food (no onion, no garlic, no potato), local vegetarian food, if requested Indian non-vegetarian food and local non-vegetarian food.

Q: What is the procedure to obtain visa to visit the said destination?

Visa is an official permit that helps you enter a foreign country and stay there for a specific period of time. Hummingbird does serve visa service. Talk to our travel consultant for visa process details for which you will have to submit certain documents.

Q: What is the best time to visit the said destination?

In spite of its relatively compact size, Southeast Asia has a shifted atmosphere that matches its varied geology however one might say that the area encounters two particular seasons - the wet and the dry. The southwest monsoon normally hits the area between June and September when numerous nations experience high rainfall and the vegetation blossoms in verdant green. The dry season between November and February is viewed as the better time to go with drier and marginally cooler climate. The hottest time of the year is usually between March and June when humidity levels ascend in preparation of the approaching downpours.

Q: Are there any direct flights from India to Thailand?

Yes, from New Delhi's Indira Gandhi International Airport to Bangkok's Suvarnabhoomi or Don Mueang Airport there are direct [flights](#) by IndiGo, Spice Jet, Air India, Thai Airways, and Thai Air Asia among others. The journey time is approximately 4.5 hours and there are frequent flights throughout the week.

Q: What is the ideal duration for the Singapore-Malaysia-Thailand tour?

The ideal duration to explore Singapore, Malaysia & Thailand would be 10 to 13 days.

Q: What is the ideal time to visit Krabi?

The best time to visit Krabi is from November to March. From June to October, Krabi experiences heavy rainfall, and which is why not many tourists travel during this time.

November to March

In this period the rains are gone and it is the coolest period to explore Krabi. With the best weather, by default, it is the busiest time of the year. This season is the perfect time to relax at the gorgeous beaches and enjoy watersports in the calm sea.

March to May

March to May believed to be the hottest months in Krabi right before monsoon hits Thailand. The temperature remains between mid-thirties and the level of humidity rises constantly. One of the reasons you should plan a trip in April is to experience the Songkran Festival and the Thai New Year where people celebrate the festival by splashing water.

June to October

From June to October, Krabi experiences monsoon season. The weather in this period is humid and the prices are low, making it one of the most cost-effective seasons to plan a holiday. It is also a peaceful time to visit because it's less crowded compared to other seasons. Continuous rainfall is witnessed during May, September, and October.

Q: What is the best time to visit Thailand?

The climate is lovely throughout the winter season, for example, November - March. And so this season is the [best time to visit Thailand](#). Summer season is comparatively hot and humid but it is a good time to try your luck at bargaining for inexpensive accommodations and flights. The rainy season, i.e. June - October, is highly unpredictable. Due to rains sometimes travelers might not be able to take up water activities.

Indian passport holders who are visiting Thailand for holidays and plan to stay for not more than 15 days in the nation can benefit the Visa on Arrival administration from the 32 assigned channels of Immigration checkpoint.

Q: Do I need three countries Visa for Singapore-Malaysia-Thailand tour?

If you wish to visit Singapore-Malaysia-Thailand in one trip, then you need to get a visa for all three countries. Thailand and Singapore do offer visa on arrival for Indian citizens. You can apply for a Malaysian visa online.

Distance from India to Krabi is approximately 3200 kilometers by air. So you can easily book a flight from India to reach Krabi that takes an average time of 10 hours.

Ensure you have sufficient money in your multi-currency card and some cash. It is smarter to buy the Thai Baht locally as you will get a better rate here than in your home country.
