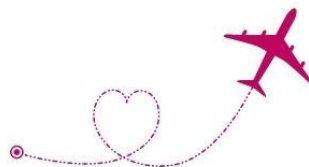

- All Indian tourists are required to hold a mandatory negative PCR test for COVID-19 conducted 48 hours prior the scheduled arrival time in Bali
- Vaccination is Mandatory for Adults - Min. 2 x vaccinated with WHO authorized vaccinations, and the 2nd vaccination must have been given at least 02 weeks prior to departure
- Children below 12 years only need a negative PCR Swab Test result.
- Children 12 years and above are considered as adult and require to be fully vaccinated
- PCR test will be conducted twice during your stay at Bali - Upon arrival at Bali airport
- PCR Charges at Bali – IDR 275.000 per person (Approx. USD 20)
- Travel insurance is Mandatory and should cover USD 25,000 insurance coverage
- Minimum 3 nights stay accommodation voucher at any CHSE certified accommodations in Bali

GENERAL

Q: What is the difference between group tours and individual tours?

Group tours consist of certain number of people touring together to a destination. Group tours can be a great way to know new people and explore well planned itinerary covering the best places. No changes will be possible in your group tour itinerary. In each destination the group consists of approximately 40 to 55 members.

Individual tours are tailor made tours designed and arranged just for you. You have a liberty to choose your own hotels, and attractions as per your taste.

Q: What is the best time to visit Bali?

Bali usually has a fairly even weather throughout the year. The average temperature in Bali stands around 30 degrees. Due to consistent temperature **Bali tours** can be planned round the year. Your preferences may vary depending on the type of traveler you are. Bali Island has two main tropical seasons: dry and wet. Dry season is from April to September and wet season is from October to March. If you like surfing then the [best time to visit Bali](#) for a holiday would be between April to September when you can play with the world's most beautiful waves on the western coast of the island. Q: Is Bali a safe destination to travel?

Bali is reasonably a safe destination to travel to. The destination has a certain level of violent crime. However, being a tourist make sure you cross roads carefully as motor bikers may rash drive. Swimmers and surfers should be careful as not all beaches are safe due to turbulent tides. Be aware of pickpockets. The threat of volcanoes, earthquakes and tsunami are always possible, but so far, Bali has not experienced any severe disasters. It has always been a tourist hot spot.

Q: Do people speak English in Bali?

Official languages of Bali are Indonesian and Balinese. Due to the tourism requirements, many people speak English till a certain extent. People in remote areas may not be able to communicate in English. Many restaurants, spas, hotels and tourism attractions have staff and guides who can communicate in English.

Q: How can I reach Bali from India?

Your Bali flight will reach the Ngurah Rai International Airport which is also known as Denpasar International Airport. The airport is located on the southernmost part of the island. It is one of the major airports of Indonesia. Denpasar International Airport is connected well to other major cities in South East Asia and via these to many other Indian cities. Various International and Domestic airline serve Bali airport which also includes multiple low-cost airlines. You can also visit Bali by road and ferry, but these options are barely recommended.

Q: Is Bali safe for female travelers?

Bali is a very laid back and safe place to explore especially for female travelers. As long as you take needed precautions and responsibilities, Bali is a safe place for a single female traveler. Just try and keep yourself surrounded by people, have a phone with you all the time so that you can immediately update your group members or the police in case of emergency.

Q: Is Bali a kids-friendly destination?

Q: Do they have facilities for visa on arrival?

You have both options possible for you. If you want you can get your visa in advance to the beginning of your travel date from the nearest Indonesian embassy in India. This is usually chosen and is recommended most of the times. Bali does offer visa on arrival for Indian citizens. The cost of the visa is US \$35. This visa is valid for up to 30 days stay in Indonesia. If you want you can also choose to extend it for another 30 days. Just make sure your passport is valid for next 6 months and should have enough space for the visa sticker.

Q: What is the best time to book Bali tour packages?

Best possible time to book a **Bali tour package** would be at least 1 month before the travel date.

Q: Which are the famous places to visit and things to do in Bali?

Top airlines that service from Singapore to Bali flights include Garuda Indonesia, Singapore Airlines, Silk Air and Qantas. Budget airlines that service Bali directly include Scoot, Jet Star, and Air Asia, offering the cheapest flights to Bali from Singapore

Q: What is the best time to visit Singapore Bali?

Singapore is a year-round destination. October-January, and June-July is certainly termed as the [best time to visit Singapore](#) and also the peak season. The city sees a big boom in the travel industry during the Christmas season and Chinese New Year while the Great Singapore sale starts in June and endures till the end of July.

The [best time to visit Bali](#) is between the months of April and October, the island's dry season. Bali encounters just two seasons: the stormy season and the dry season.
