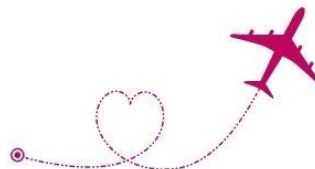

Bird life include common species like the lesser and Greater Hummingbird, African fish Eagle, Tawny Eagle, Green Wood Hoopoes, Cliff Chat, Great White and Pink Backed Pelicans plus other intra- African Migrants, Dinner and overnight at Lake Nakuru National Park

## Lake Nakuru - Masai-Mara

### Transportation:

- In one car, only 6 pax can accommodate at max, so of the number of passengers are more, the cars need to be booked accordingly.
- A local English Speaking Drive come Guide will be available for each Vehicle during your tour for Kenya & Tanzania.
- In Kenya all the vehicles are Non AC so kindly take a note of that.

### Luggage:

- The luggage allowance on our schedule flights is strictly 15kgs per person and that soft bags are highly

recommended, if not essential. In light aircraft the baggage area and weight allowance is limited.

- Hard Samsonite type suitcases do not fit into the cargo compartment easily, if at all.
- Due to limited space available for storage in safari vehicles, we strongly recommend use soft duffle bags rather than hard suitcases.

**Note for Road Conditions in Kenya & Tanzania:**

- The road situations in Kenya & Tanzania and the surrounding are unpaved roads, and sometimes are tough to pass through even in 4 x 4 vehicles with high clearance. The roads are quite muddy and full of potholes so passengers having any back problems or any issues; are suggested to take precautions accordingly.

**Kenya Entry Requirements:**

- All travelers are required to have a negative PCR COVID-19 test result taken within 72 hours before traveling to Kenya.
- All travelers are required to have a negative PCR COVID-19 test result taken; at most, 72 hours before travelling back home.
- As of 1st Jan 2021 all Visa applications are to be made online through the website: <http://evisa.go.ke/evisa.html>, there will be no visa on arrival.
- Passengers MUST complete the Travelers Health Surveillance from: [https://ears.health.go.ke/airline\\_registration/](https://ears.health.go.ke/airline_registration/)
- There is currently no quarantine required for persons entering Kenya.
- It is not required to take a COVID-19 test upon entry to Kenya.
- Visitors traveling to Kenya require a valid yellow fever vaccination certificate before travel.

# GOT QUESTIONS?

## GENERAL

### Q: What is the difference between group tours and individual tours?

Group tours consist of certain number of people touring together to a destination. Group tours can be a great way to know new people and explore well planned itinerary covering the best places. No changes will be possible in your group tour itinerary. In each destination the group consists of approximately 40 to 55 members.

Individual tours are tailor made tours designed and arranged just for you. You have a liberty to choose your own hotels, and attractions as per your taste.

### Q: What are the different modes of transportation provided to passengers on tour?

At the time of booking, passengers are given different options to choose their mode of transportation like:

In Private Transfer you can also choose to do sightseeing by private vehicle which will be available from one point to another. The private vehicle will be pre-booked on a pre-decided route and timings decided in advance as well.

Vehicle at disposal means that a car will be with you throughout the travel trip for which timings and kilometers will be decided in advance. If you use the car outside the travel package distance or time limit then it may not be possible or it will charged additionally. Vehicle at disposal offers more flexibility and control over the itinerary. Also private van tours include a coach at service.

SIC (Seat in coach basis) SIC coach transfers depart only at fixed times and stop at different hotels enroute where other passengers may be picked up or dropped off which mean it time consuming. You will be traveling with other passengers and passengers of different nationalities which offers a good chance to interact with people from different parts of the world. Before joining the tour you need to exchange tour vouchers for your original tickets from the concerned office. Many time the tour starting point is not from the hotel so then you need to reach the departure point from your hotel at your own expense.

### Q: What kind of food is offered to travelers on tour?

Meals which will be provided on tour will be mentioned in your tour itinerary. Usually meal menu contains of Indian vegetarian food, Jain food (no onion, no garlic, no potato), local vegetarian food, if requested Indian non- vegetarian food and local non-vegetarian food.

### Q: What is the procedure to obtain visa to visit the said destination?

Visa is an official permit that helps you enter a foreign country and stay there for a specific period of time. Hummingbird does serve visa service. Talk to our travel consultant for visa process details for which you will have to submit certain documents.

### Q: What is the best time to book?

**Q: What is the best time to visit the said destination?**

Most tourists opt to explore Australia during spring that is from September to November and during autumn that is from March to May as the best seasons to visit Australia. The climate during these seasons is neither too hot nor too chilly that makes it perfect to have a stroll around. You can likewise maintain a strategic distance from the bustling summer break and Christmas break that will guarantee that you get moderate flights to Australia.

New Zealand is a mountainous island country sitting disconnected in the Southwest Pacific, thus the climate will in general be really flighty. All things considered, it implies that you can visit New Zealand at any time of the year and still get heavenly days! Here at the base of the world seasons are opposite towards the Northern Hemisphere's and a many people who visit New Zealand visit during midyear season, which is December through February.

South Africa is an all year goal: diverse pieces of the nation are progressively attractive at various occasions of the year. Wildlife seeing is best from June through October, however you can tailor the planning of your trip as per what intrigues you the most. For the Cape region, the peak season is from November to March, which are the hotter summer months.
